



# Wyoming Delta Dental Foundation's Wyoming Smiles Senior Dental Program - 2023

Low-Cost Dental Insurance Program for Qualifying Seniors

To qualify for the program, individuals must:

- ⦿ Be a resident of Wyoming, living in Wyoming.
- ⦿ Be age 65+.
- ⦿ **Cannot be covered by any dental insurance** or being provided free dental coverage by other programs.
- ⦿ Have a combined household income within the range shown in the income chart.
- ⦿ Submit Proof of income (Social Security Award letter or 2021 taxes or paystubs). [Proof of Income MUST be Submitted with the application](#)
- ⦿ Be able to travel to a dental office for treatment within 60 days of being accepted into the program (or show proof of treatment prior to being in the program).

Household size is defined as you, your spouse or any dependent children.

Gross income is your total income before taxes or deductions. Please report your gross income.

**Proof of income must be submitted with the application.**

Please send a copy of the first page of the most recent tax return for your household.

If your household does not file taxes, please provide documentation showing your annual total household income such as:

- ⦿ Social security award letters
- ⦿ A copy of your most recent W-2 forms
- ⦿ Pension statements, interest statements, etc.



## 2023 Program Details

The Wyoming Smiles Senior Dental program covers a range of dental benefits (see services covered) including preventive, basic and major services up to \$1,500.

There will also be availability for a limited number of eligible seniors to receive a full denture set (if needed) during 2023.

The Denture funding availability will be on a first come first serve basis based on claims received. Claims must be pre-authorized by your dentist. If they are not pre-authorized the dentures will not be covered under the denture program and will be subject to the annual maximum of \$1,500.

## Services Covered

- ⊙ Exams
- ⊙ Cleanings (prophylaxis) or Periodontal maintenance
- ⊙ Bitewing x-rays
- ⊙ Full mouth/panoramic x-rays
- ⊙ Fluoride applications - once per year
- ⊙ Emergency treatment for relief of pain
- ⊙ Amalgam Fillings
- ⊙ Some Root Canals
- ⊙ Crowns
- ⊙ Extractions
- ⊙ Dentures & Denture repairs

Services outlined in this brochure are a partial listing of covered dental services

There are no premiums or deductibles, however there is a \$5 co-pay for major services.



## Next Steps:

- ⊙ We will review your application and let you know whether you have been accepted into this year's program.
- ⊙ The Wyoming Smiles Senior Dental program has a limited number of spaces available each year for eligible seniors. Eligibility is on a first come, first serve basis.
- ⊙ Once all available spaces are filled, a waiting list will be developed.
- ⊙ If you are accepted into the program, we will send you information on how to find a dentist and get started.
- ⊙ The information in this brochure is valid October 1, 2022 - May 1, 2023, however the benefit year for those accepted is **January 1, 2023 - December 31, 2023**
